TERMS OF SALE

- 1. The Auctioneer has final authority on the amount of each bid and the identity of the buyer. To obtain a listing of the fair market value of the items featured in tonight's live and silent auctions, please see the treasurer's table.
- 2. The buyer must sign a receipt acknowledging the bid each time an item is purchased. All items must be paid for and claimed the night of the event. All sales are final. There will be no refunds or exchanges. Payment may be made by cash, check or credit card.
- 3. Proof of payment is required before an item may be claimed. After payment is made a "Paid Receipt" will be provided. Please show this receipt when claiming your item(s) and leaving.
- 4. If you purchase or win a firearm, all federal, state, and local laws will apply. You will need to complete the sale through a federal firearms licensee, including the completion of all required paperwork and background checks. Firearms not claimed within 30 days will remain the property of the Mountain Home-White River Friends of NRA committee unless otherwise specified by the state. Any fees associated with the transfer of the firearm are the responsibility of the winner or purchaser.
- 5. This event is conducted under the auspices of The Second Amendment Legacy Foundation, a 501©(3) organization, but please consult your tax advisor regarding the tax deductibility of any purchase made.
- 6. Raffle Drawings Ticket numbers will be called three times. If the winner is not identified, a new number will be called and the first number will be void. All raffle winners must be present to win with ticket stub unless otherwise stated in the program or on the specific raffle ticket.
- 7. A buyer claiming sales tax exemption must provide a copy of their tax determination form at the time of purchase.
- 8. The purchaser or winner of any merchandise or other item bought or won at this event ("merchandise") agrees that he or she had the opportunity to inspect the merchandise and that the merchandise is in good condition and is acceptable to the purchaser or winner. The purchaser or winner accepts the merchandise as is and agrees and understands that no refunds or exchanges will be offered or provided after he or she takes possession of the merchandise. Merchandise not claimed within 30 days will remain property of The Second Amendment Legacy Foundation committee unless otherwise specified by the state.

- 10. Everyone who wins or purchases a firearm must complete a Firearms Transaction Record (Form 4473) for the National Instant Check System (NICS). You may not take possession of any firearms until your NICS check is approved.
